Title	"The Gospel Ladder"
Speaker	Nate Howard
Main Idea/Theme	The message looks at how the gospel actually works in the Christian life — not as a first step we move beyond, but as the ongoing source of everything else. Using the image of a "ladder," we'll look at the difference between moving down vs moving up. the only direction that's actually good news is down — everything flows from who God is and what He's done, not what we can pull off. Big Idea: The gospel isn't a first step we move beyond — it's the hub we keep returning to. All growth comes from applying it deeper, not moving past it. 1. The Gospel Ladder (down) Who God is → What God does → Who we are → What we do Being precedes doing. What we believe about God shapes everything else. 2. The False Gospel (up) If I do enough → then I become / then God responds. Identity rests on performance. God becomes only as good as what He does for us. 3. So What? When life happens, pause before reacting. Ask: What's true about God? What's He done? What's He made me? Then — what would I do? Closing: Only one direction is good news — down. Who we are and what we do flows from who God is and what He's done. Songs that lean into grace, identity in Christ, or God's initiating love rather than striving/performance themes — that contrast is central to the message.
